**Delivery:** includes eye contact, projection of voice, stage presence, clarity of speech.

**Creativity:** degree to which you show ability to solve the problems the assignment presents; includes originality and honors risks to try different approaches to solve problems.

**Knowledge/Expertise:** reflects the overall fluency of your knowledge regarding your subject. This is measured by what you say and how you are able to answer people's questions; also by the extent to which specific details reveal the depth of your understanding of the subject. If appropriate, evaluates the quality and effective use of examples to support and illustrate.

**Visuals/Aids:** this refers to the use and quality of any presentation aids you use. Does not assume you must have a visual or multimedia aid to present successfully; this is meant to assess the extent to which your aids, if you have any, are effectively created and used in your presentation.

**Insight:** the degree to which your work shows insight into the subject at hand. This is different from knowledge/expertise; if they deal with the what/who, insight deals with the why/how/so?

**Process:** another word for this is *preparation*: to what extent does your presentation suggest you prepared your materials and speech for this presentation; or does it look like you are making it up as you go along.

**Benchmark:** quality of this work in relation to your past work and my expectations of what you should be able to do.
